Hertz Equipment Rental Commits to Playground

Hertz Equipment Rental announced its support of The Rotary Adventure Playground at Freedom Park by committing to providing more than \$5,000 in tools and equipment to fuel the upcoming build May 19 – 23, 2010. “The playground is built by volunteers and through the use of borrowed and lent tools,” explained Greg Gilday Project Manager. “This is a massive community effort and we are depending on the community to make it come together in only a handful of days.”

“The support from Hertz Equipment Rental is deeply appreciated and will make a huge difference in the ability of the hundreds of volunteers to make the build a success,” explained Gilday. The playground is a \$200,000 venture that has raised more than \$140,000 in the past few months as well as attracting more than 400 volunteers to help build the playground this Spring.

The playground is created through donations of time, talent, materials and cash from every member of the Stanwood Camano Community. The project will break ground later this Spring with an intensive build process for five days. “The build relies on having all of the necessary components and volunteers to make the magic of dreams become reality,” said Gilday.
